It is our great pleasure and honour to welcome you to the **1st Panhellenic Conference on Child and Adolescent Neuropsychology**, which will be held on **9–11 April 2027** in **Florina, Greece**.

The Conference aspires to become the first major scientific meeting for the Greek community working in Child and Adolescent Neuropsychology and one of the first scientific events in Europe devoted exclusively to this rapidly evolving field. Through keynote lectures, symposia, oral and poster presentations, workshops, and panel discussions, participants will have the opportunity to explore the latest scientific advances, present their research, exchange ideas, and establish new national and international collaborations.

Beyond disseminating current scientific knowledge, the Conference aims to bridge basic and applied research with clinical and educational practice, contributing to the development of a strong interdisciplinary scientific network that will promote the advancement of Child and Adolescent Neuropsychology in Greece while strengthening its international presence.
